



ArcGIS License

1. On your computer, open the ArcGIS Pro application. Click the link "Configure Licensing."

2. In the License Type field, select "Named User License."

Under the section "Configure your licensing options," select "ArcGIS Online."

Set the URL to <https://upsystem.maps.arcgis.com>

Then, click OK.



3. After configuring the licensing settings, you will return to the application portal.






5. After logging in successfully, your ArcGIS Pro application will relaunch and it will show the application dashboard.
