# Installer

STEP 1: Open the Java download page by clicking on this link:

STEP 2: Download Windows Offline.

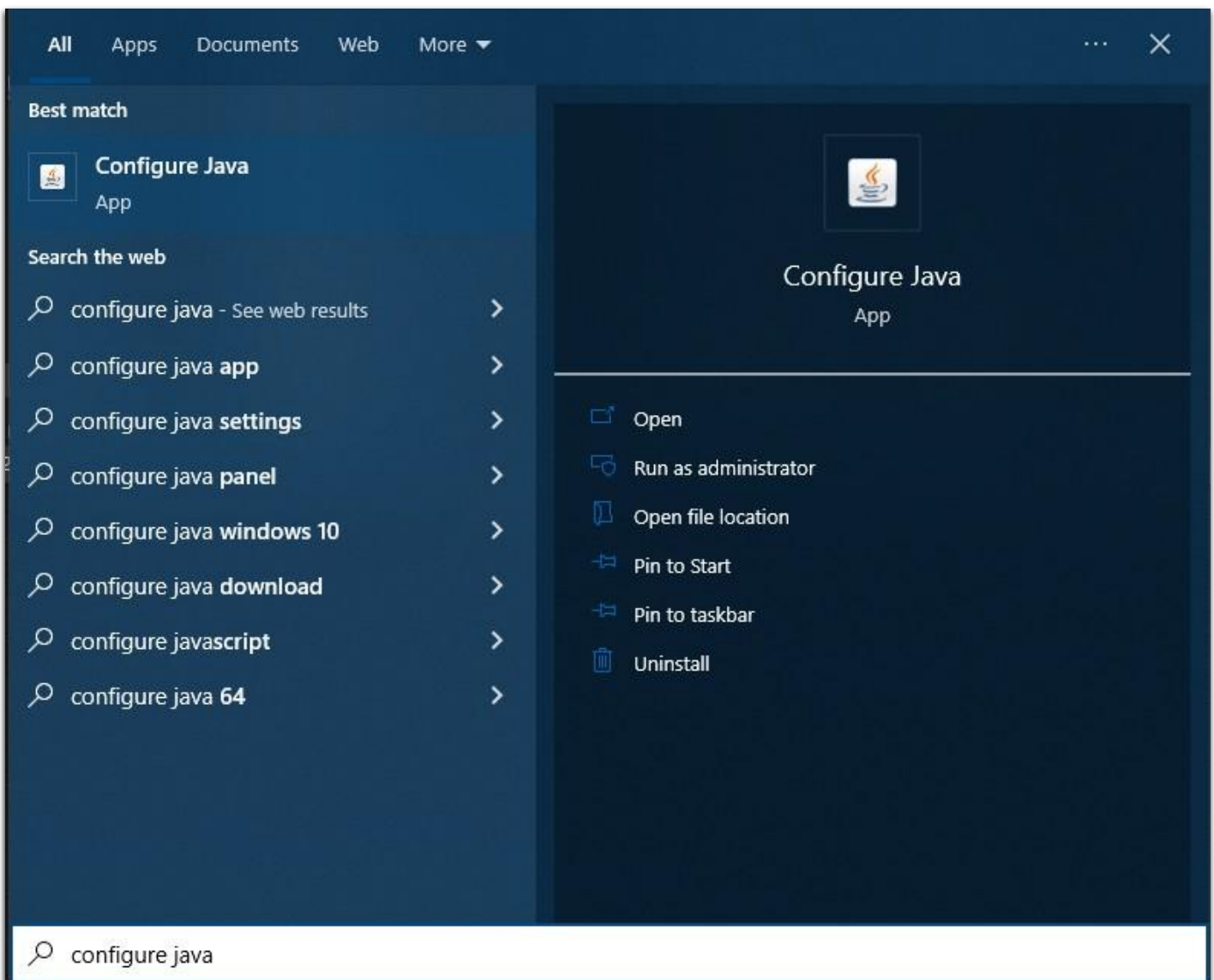

STEP 1: Launch *Windows Start Menu*.

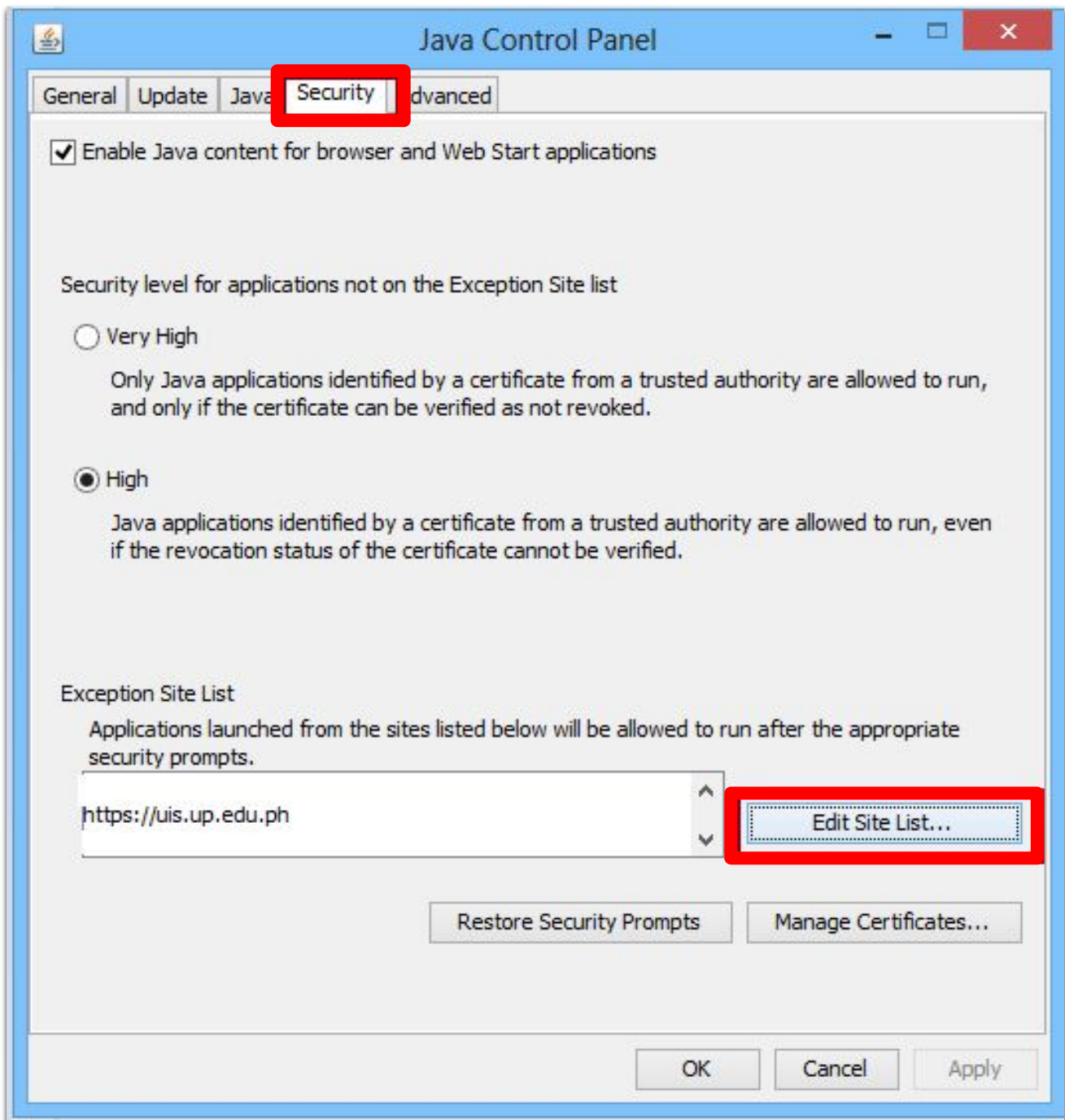
Then, search for *Configure JAVA*.

STEP 2: Click *Security* tab, then click *Edit Site List*.

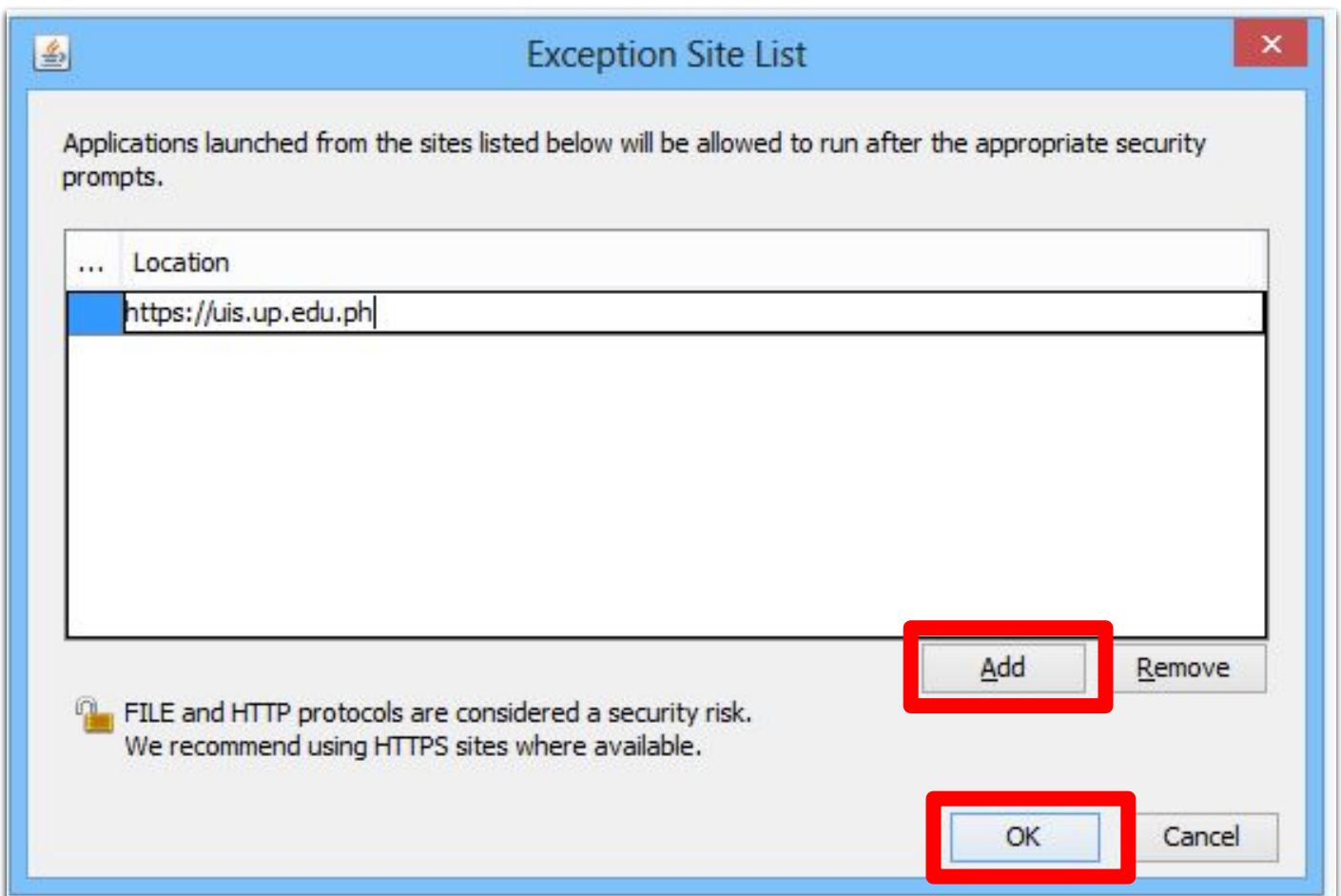

STEP 3: Click the *Add* button.

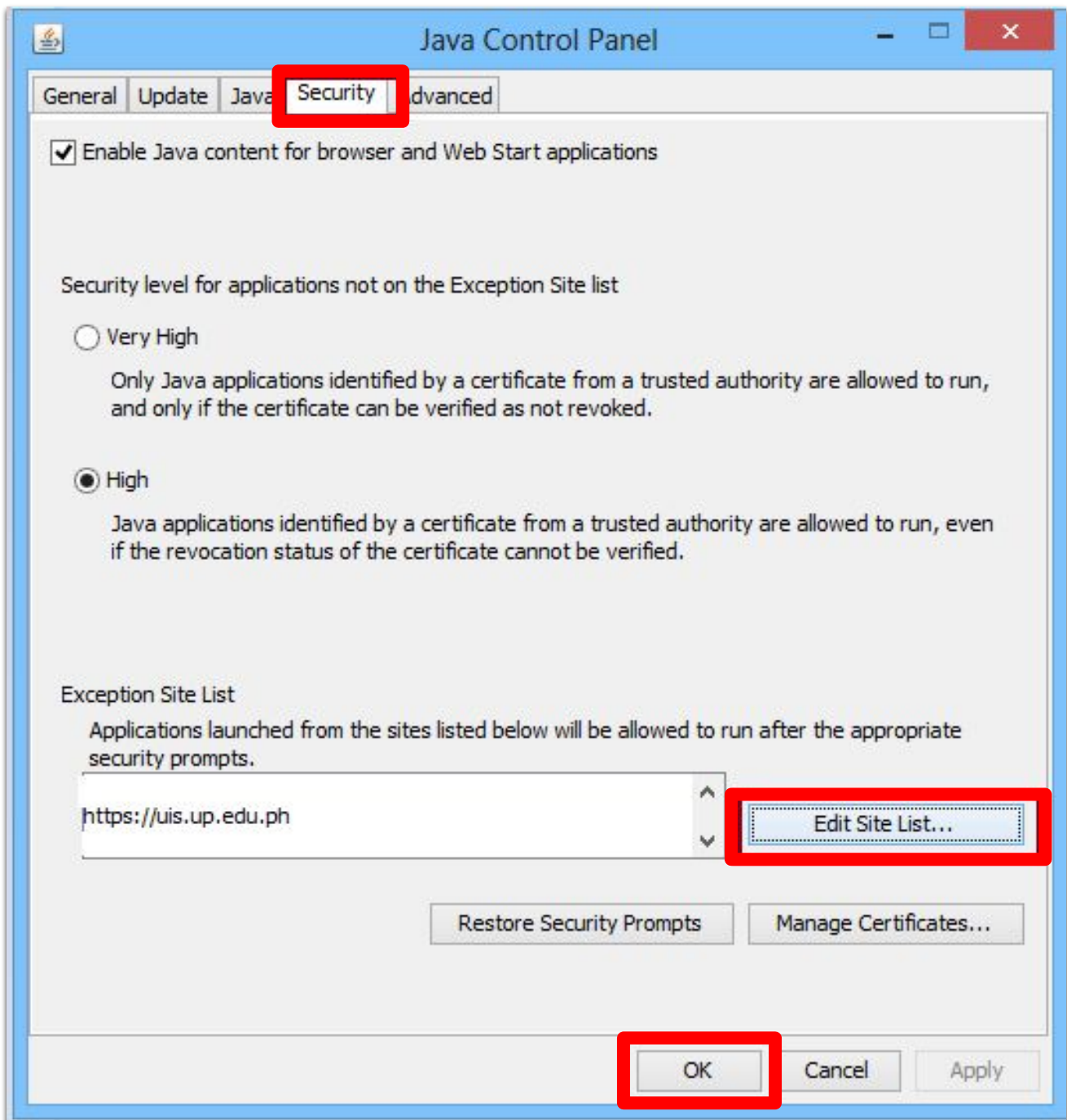
Enter this URL: <https://uis.up.edu.ph>
